## Drop In Sessions Here at Axis Youth Hub

Axis Youth Hub is getting very busy with organisations getting involved and coming into Axis Youth Hub and holding drop in sessions. We are fortunate to have Babcock Prime coming in fortnightly, DWP fortnightly, CCP weekly, a Care Leavers PA is based here every Monday, The Point come in fortnightly, and Pathways are based here on Mondays. We also have a counsellor who is dedicated to Axis Youth Hub on a Wednesday.

Agencies have said that their referral numbers have increased, and young people attending appointments have also increased since holding these sessions at Axis Youth House.
